## Message from the Head of School

I hope that you are all enjoying this extra day out of school with your children. In school today, during our INSET training, the staff have been reviewing the long-term plans for our curriculum. We have looked at how different subjects can be aligned across the year and are creating summary documents for each year group. When these are completed, we will share them with our families, so that you can see the overview for learning for all subjects in each year group across the school year. We will then be reviewing the progression of skills, knowledge and vocabulary that will be taught in each class by subject, for each block of teaching.

In our recent parent questionnaire, we received several comments from parents requesting that school find a way to make parents aware of what their child has been learning about in class. We are considering a variety of different ways that this could be done and hope to begin this sharing of information at the start of the next academic year.

This week's newsletter covers the last two weeks' worth of events at school, due to the Summer Fayre being held on Friday afternoon last week. I am sure that you will agree, if you came along, that it was a fun-packed afternoon in the sun on our school field, organised by our very own PTA, where parents and teachers came together to raise funds for the children at Scotch Orchard Primary School. It was extremely well attended, and we would like to thank everyone who was able to stay after school to take part in the fundraising. Additional thanks must also go to the Year 6 children, who helped to set up the fayre and man stalls during the event. We can't wait to hear how much was raised.

Earlier on Friday, the children in Year 5 attended the Coton Centre Entrust Concert, where they demonstrated their fantastic guitar skills to a packed audience of parents and loved ones. We are so proud of our Year 5 children – as they have made such excellent progress over the year – and would like to thank Mr Walters for his high-quality teaching that allowed all the children to take part in this event. On Monday this week, Year 3 attended the Lichfield Cathedral Pilgrimage, where they took part in a fascinating workshop, which the children all thoroughly enjoyed. Last night was our Rights Respecting School Steering Groups UNICEF film night for Soccer Aid. £283.77 was raised in total through the penalty shoot-out and the film night combined. Thanks must go to Dylan and Henry (Y6) for organising this event.

## Car Parking outside school

Please can I remind all parents to **park considerately** when dropping off or collecting children from school. Please do not park over people's drives, or on pavements – as I am receiving complaints from local residents indicating that their cars are being blocked on their drives and this has caused people to miss GP and hospital appointments, as well as from people with pushchairs or wheelchairs who are having to go onto the road as they are unable to get past cars on pavements. The PCSO's have advised that residents should photograph the car/number plates and report it to Staffordshire police – via their online form – for the Police to take action.

### Attendance Update

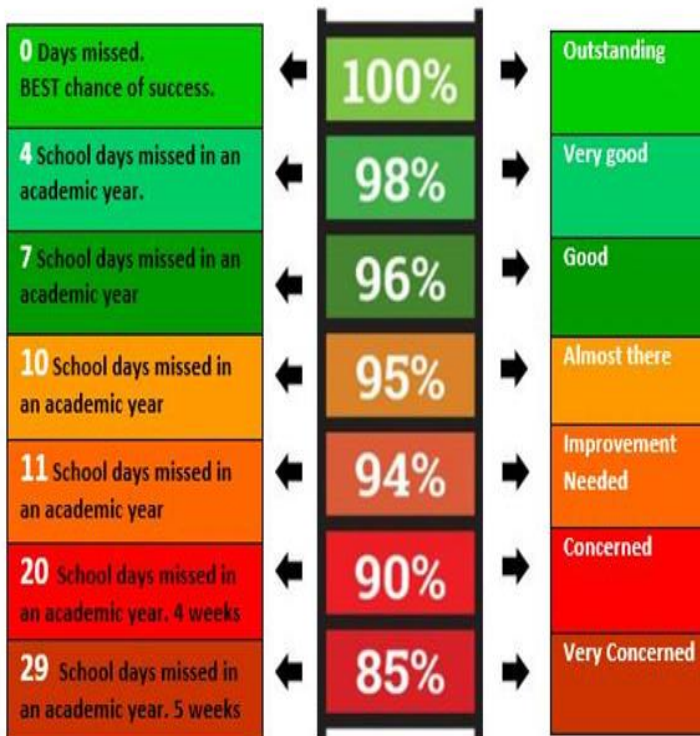
Regular, punctual attendance at school is important for your child.
