Homework routines from September

Year 2 children will continue to access our Book Banded reading scheme, which will be carefully matched to their phonic level. In order to promote all children to develop a love of reading, we will be expecting them to read to an adult at home at least three times a week and record this in their reading diary. The children can also choose a book from our school library to enjoy at home.

Weekly spellings will be set which will focus on common exception words, letter strings, sounds or spelling rules.

Children will be set weekly Maths homework, including games and activities which will consolidate the learning taking place in school and further develop their fluency and confidence in Maths.
